Things are hard for everyone right now. But imagine going through this without furniture in your home.





Starting Monday, May 11, Community Warehouse will accept the following items:

- ***Kitchen tables***
- ***Kitchen chairs***
- ***Dishware*** (plates, bowls, cups, and silverware - no china or metal-rimmed dishware)
- ***Cookware*** (pots, pans, cooking utensils)
- ***Small appliances*** (microwaves, toasters, coffee makers)
- ***Sofas*** (no sleeper sofas, sectionals, or recliners)
- ***Armchairs***

You may drop off these items at our [Portland Warehouse](#) between 10 AM - 4 PM on weekdays only. (We'll accept any spare change in your couch cushions, too!)

If you have other furniture or household items to donate, please hold onto them until Community Warehouse can accept other items.


